2012 TRAINER SERVICE PROGRAM

The National Youth Cutting Horse Association's Trainer Service Program was established as a fundraiser to help ensure the growth and progress of the NYCHA and its youth programs.

THE TRAINER PROGRAM IS AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE BY ALL AGES

NYCHA Trainer Service Program Conditions

Trainer services are donated to the NYCHA and the donated services will be offered for sale through the NYCHA Trainer Service Program. Trainers must be a member in good standing with a trainer's status. Trainers listed have a minimum lifetime NCHA earnings of \$25,000. Information on donated trainer services will be published in the Cutting Horse Chatter, listed on the NCHA/NYCHA website's, NCHA E-News, possibly mentioned on 2:30, The NCHA's Video News Show and ncharadio.com.

As a condition of this contract the Trainer must agree to the following:

1. Offer 2 days of lessons (hours of each day of lessons will be solely between the trainer and trainee)
2. Provide stalling of trainee's personal horse
3. Once the donated training sessions have been sold, the NYCHA will notify the trainer. The contact name and phone number of the trainer will be given to the purchaser and/or trainee. Training arrangements will be made between donor (trainer) and purchaser (trainee). NYCHA is not responsible for booking dates or any additional fees associated with this donation.

Bidder/Purchaser (Trainee) conditions:

1. Purchaser (trainee) must register in order to place a bid online at www.nychatrainerauction.com
2. Persons may submit a bid on any number of trainers
3. Bidding is open to all NCHA members
4. The person purchasing the training session is responsible for providing their own personal horse, feed, and accommodations for themselves, stall will be provided for the horse
5. Training sessions purchased through the NYCHA trainer auction are not transferrable and may not be re-sold by the purchaser

Online Bidding

- Minimum bid starts at \$250.00
- Bids will increase in increments of \$100.00
- Bids are binding and may not be retracted once submitted
- The winning bidder for each training session must submit a check made out to the NYCHA or pay by credit card within 5 working days of the auction close date of April 1, 2012
- The training session does not include accommodations for person purchasing session or any travel expenses

Trainer Donation Auction Procedures

All trainers services donated to the program will be offered for sale online at nychatrainerauction.com. Donated training sessions will be offered starting February 1, 2012 through April 1, 2012.

Any trainer purchased through the NYCHA Trainer Service Program may not be transferred or re-sold by the purchaser. Services are for the 2012 year. Any carryover to a future year is at the sole discretion of the trainer donating the services.

Important Notice:

The purpose of this program is to provide funds for scholarships, awards, prizes, and other activities to promote and encourage participation in Cutting by NYCHA youth members. In view of this purpose, there will be no refund of winning bids for any reason. After the bidding has been completed, any transaction dealing with the training session will be solely between the trainer and trainee. It will in no way involve the NCHA or NYCHA. Submitting a contract indicates acceptance of the foregoing statements.
